Title: USDA Announces Federal Order Regarding Swine Enteric Coronavirus Diseases

What: On June 5, 2014 USDA APHIS VS announced a new federal order concerning novel swine enteric coronavirus diseases (SECD), including porcine epidemic diarrhea virus (PEDV) and porcine delta coronavirus (PDCoV). We are summarizing the main portions of that announcement here and have attached supporting documents as well. The Colorado State Veterinarian's Office values the Colorado swine industry and wants to assist veterinarians in their endeavor to keep their clients' herds healthy. We appreciate you working with us to implement this new Federal Order.

This order affects all levels of swine production from small backyard facilities to large-scale producers. If you are a veterinarian with clients involved in the swine industry please familiarize yourself with this federal order. More details will be coming in the near future, but there are some key features you need to be aware of today.

Most importantly, effective immediate PEDV and PDCoV are reportable diseases in Colorado and across the U.S.

Who the Federal Order Affects: Veterinarians, Swine Producers of any size, and Laboratories

What to Report: Any Confirmed Positive Case(s) with clinical signs consistent with the case definition (see definitions in SECD Case Definitions part 3.3 in the attached PDF).
